

## Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch up Premium

### Allocation for Financial year 2016-2017 £15673

The literacy and numeracy catch up premium is allocated to Haslingden High School to support Year 7 students who did not meet the expected standard score in reading and/ or numeracy. 80 being the lowest scaled score which can be awarded.

### Allocation of Catch up Premium

Of the students identified, some receive Specialist Literacy teacher provision, 1x 50mins per week. This provision runs from October 2016 to June 2017. The remaining group of students are divided into 3 groupings according to their ability. For the higher ability group of students there are 3 assessment pieces of work, that indicates progress over the week, (spellings, know words and story starters). The middle group is very similar, however more interactive in order to engage students whilst maintaining a strong focus on sentence structure and literacy techniques. There is a greater emphasis on punctuation and grammar. The lower group will include more focus on phonics and sequencing that is an essential part of learning. There are 2 assessment pieces of work to show progress; phonics and alphabet quiz.

### Allocation of Catch up Premium

Of the students identified, some receive Numeracy Provision 4x 15mins per week. This provision runs from October 2016- June 2017. From the remaining group, students have been further divided into 3 groups according to their ability. All students are assessed at the beginning of the week and end of the week with a progress test, which has been created by the maths department and focuses on the year 7 curriculum, enabling over -learning. Over the week the main focuses are timetables, time, area, perimeter, volume and shapes. With the lower ability group the topics covered are the same with more basic skills included. Date for Literacy week is the week beginning 26<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Date for the Numeracy week is the week beginning 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2017.
